There's an online sign-up to eliminate long lines and wait times, sensory-friendly playground and activities, sensory tools such as therapy dogs from the Marin Humane Society to maintain a calm atmosphere, and an understanding Santa. A professional photographer will be there to capture the special moments and provide each family with a photo of their child with Santa. The event is complimentary, with \$20 raffle tickets being sold to benefit Matrix Parent Network & Resource Cen-

ter. Each raffle ticket includes 1 entry into their exciting raffle with prizes such as a 4-night stay in Tahoe and a luxury hotel stay in Sonoma.

All too often, families of children with special needs have to opt-out of community events given the challenge in participating. It was because of this, that the *Sensitive Santa* event was created; to celebrate *all* children and bring excitement and inclusion to an otherwise stressful event, creating a fun holiday ritual.

All Children Academics is a specialized private school for children with academic and social learning differences who serves children in transitional kindergarten through 5th grade.
