DREDF will discuss how to develop an Individual Transition Plan as part of the Individual Education Program process for youth. We will provide tips and advocacy strategies to families and caregivers on how to use the transition process effectively and discuss ways to shift the focus of the IEP from the parent and school's goals to a youth centered approach.

Matrix will provide a walk-through of the ITP form (Individual Transition Plan, part of the IEP), highlighting specific information which should be found on the ITP. We will also discuss how the 3 main post-secondary goals of the ITP connect to the activities that support them and to the annual IEP goals.

Learning about the transition to adulthood process and understanding how to help build robust ITPs empowers youth (and their parents) to be effective members of their IEP teams.
