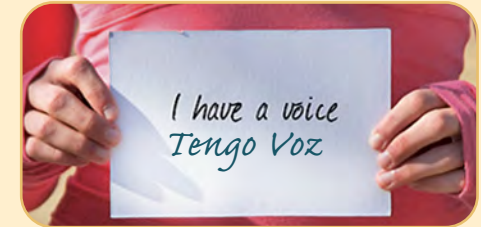

It cannot go without saying that the reason that Matrix is such an amazing resource is the people working there, tirelessly, many of whom have their own children with special needs at home.”

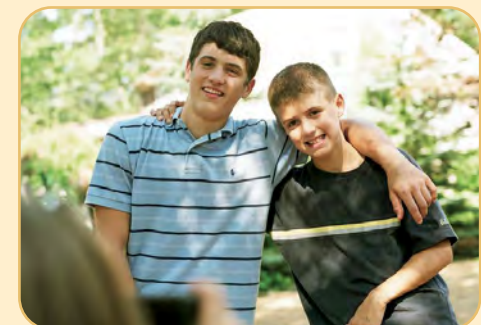
